### Summer Term 1 Theme – Vicious Vikings



#### English

In English, we will use a range of texts with a Viking theme to learn the tricks and tips for successful narrative writing. We will also be reading and performing poetry and writing explanation texts.

#### Maths

Maths will continue to follow the National Curriculum and the advice of the NCETM. We will revisit length and perimeter and tackle word problems involving addition and subtraction. Later in the half term, we will explore fractions and decimals in greater depth.

#### Science

In science, we will be investigating electricity: building and testing circuits and experimenting with the effects that changes on a circuit have on its efficiency. We will also learn about electrical safety.

#### History / Geography

Our topic this term is history based and we will investigate why the Vikings invaded Britain and how life changed for the people already living here. From our 21<sup>st</sup> century viewpoint, we will consider the Viking legacy to our country.

#### Art and Design / Design Technology

Art this term will be based on Viking artefacts and the children will explore Norse patterns and printing and will create Viking jewellery.

#### Music

Music and poetry from Japan will feature in our exploration of Haiku and the Blossom Festival of Hanami. The children will listen to traditional music and create their own versions.

#### French

In French, we will continue to develop our understanding of the position of an adjective in a sentence and how it 'agrees' with the noun it is describing. We will learn how to describe ourselves and others.

#### RE

The Christian festival of Pentecost will be the focus for our RE studies this half term. The children will explore why Christians celebrate at this time and what impact it has on their daily lives.

#### Computing

Our computing lessons have a meteorological twist as we look at gathering weather data with the help of technology. At the end of our topic we will create a broadcast to share our information.
