



Theme – Eureka! (Ancient Greece)

English – Greek Myths

In English, we will be looking at three focus texts from Greek mythology. Theseus and the Minotaur, Pandora's box and Icarus. The class will use these texts to create newspaper articles, character descriptions and letters. Then, using our knowledge of Greek myths we will then plan, design and write our own.

Maths

We will continue to work on statistics, creating and analysing bar charts and tables. From there we will begin our unit of fractions. Looking at the part and whole, unit and non-unit fractions. We will look at how we use fractions to describe things and find fractions of amounts.

Science – Animals Including Humans

This term we will be looking at animals including humans. We will look at what makes a balanced diet and how we can encourage people to eat healthy. We will learn the names of the bones in the human body and how muscles make our bodies move.

History - The ancient Greeks

To begin this topic we will taste test Greek food. Then we will look at what life was like in Ancient Greece. We will look at the people of Athens and Sparta and the Olympic games. We will consider how Greek has influenced our language, theatre and writing. We will look at the Greek Gods and their myths and legends.

Art and Design / Design Technology

This term our focus is food technology. We will be sampling and rating different types of bread. From there we will research Greek pitta bread recipes in order to compare the ingredients and methods. The class will then design and create their own pitta bread recipe. This will include pricing their own ingredients.

Music – Jazz

We will begin the topic by looking at ragtime and syncopated rhythm. We then look at Dixieland and their use of call and response alongside scat singing. We will create and listen to jazz motifs. To end this topic the children will create their own swing version of a nursery rhyme.

French – In the Classroom

To start we will learn French classroom commands and the items you might find in a classroom. The children will learn how to ask for items and tell people what equipment they have.

RE – what kind of world did Jesus want?

We will be thinking about Jesus's disciples and why they were chosen. We will look at the story of the leper and how Jesus treated everyone the same. From there we will think about the role churches play in our community and look at the day in the life of a church leader.

Computing- What is a network?

We will think about what a school network is and how information moves around it. From here, we will look at how the internet works and the role that routers play.
