



Theme – The Amazing Americas

English

Once SATs are over, we will be looking at North American authors and poets. We will base our learning around 'Brown Girl Dreaming' by Jacqueline Woodson. We will also be looking at topical issues and honing our debating skills This will be aided by 'Change Sings' by Amanda Gorman.

Maths

Post SATs, we will focus on more investigative maths, revisiting all our skills and linking it to our science and geography topics. In particular, we will be revisiting reading and plotting co-ordinates in greater detail.

Science

We will be classifying the flora and fauna of North America as well as investigating electrical circuits. We will also recap on scientific knowledge gained during our time at Worfield.

History / Geography - Amazing Americas

Having studied much of South America in the company of Charles Darwin, our gaze will turn north as we look at the people and places of this huge continent. We will also do some detailed map work, comparing the human and physical geography of our region with that of North America.

Art and Design / Design Technology

The focus of our learning this term will be on the Mexican artist Frida Kahlo. We will investigate her bold colourful techniques and create work in her style. We will also be creating props for our end of term play.

Music

America will also feature in our music lessons as 'Brecon sings the Blues'! After half term, we will focus on composing music for the Leavers' Service.

French

Back by popular demand, Albert will lead us through a unit linked to our computing Space Race theme We will learn planet names and compare them using a range of adjectives. Then he will help us get ready for 'Les Vacances' as we learn how to talk about our holidays.

RE

We will be exploring the Christian concept of Jesus as King and looking at why people of different beliefs turn to their Faith when times are hard.

Computing

America will feature in our computing too as we enter the Space Race! We will be looking at how the Mars Rover was designed and how it transmitted data home to Planet Earth. There will **not** be a trip to Mars!
