Dear Parent,

This week we are delighted to have welcomed Mrs Tracy Phillips to our staff team. Mrs Phillips is doing a number of roles within our school. She is meeting the school buses each morning and receiving children at 'Kiss and Drop Off' and she is our Senior Lunchtime Supervisor. Each morning during lesson time, Mrs Phillips is supporting teaching and learning, mainly in Year 4.

Mrs Phillips' has joined Worfield School from Telford and Wrekin Local Authority where she worked as an Early Intervention Practitioner. Mrs Phillips' afternoon work at Worfield school will continue to be as an Early Intervention Practitioner. This role will see Mrs Phillips delivering one to one and small group interventions to support children's emotional wellbeing; developing their self-esteem, building confidence and independence. Mrs Phillips will also be a point of contact for any parent who feels they want to talk about any concerns they may have at home which impact on their child. Mrs Phillips can offer parents advice and support with regards to school attendance, children's routines at home, children's behaviours and understanding their child's needs, as well as being able to signpost parents to other services within the local authority which may be beneficial to them or their child. Mrs Phillips will be offering some informal drop-in sessions shortly for parents who want some advice but in the meantime do not hesitate to make contact via the school office if you would like to arrange an informal chat with Mrs Phillips over a cup of coffee!

On Wednesday evening at the Autumn Term meeting of The Trinity Federation Governing Body, the School Development Plan for this academic year was approved. The full document is now available on our website should you wish to read it. One priority within the plan is to further improve school attendance at Worfield School. Last year we saw an increase in absences due to illness but also in unauthorised absences. Please can I remind parents of the need to inform the school office if their child is absent from school due to illness. Requests for any leave of absence in term time should be made to myself. A form, available from the office, must be completed before any leave can be considered. Leave of absence is only granted in exceptional circumstances. In the New Year we will be launching a number of initiatives designed to promote good school attendance; ensuring those children who attend everyday get recognition.

Rehearsals for our EYFS and KS1 Nativity plays are now well underway and across our KS2 classes the sounds of Christmas are beginning to be heard. Dates for all of our Christmas events can be found on our online calendar. Please ensure that you have reserved your tickets for the EYFS and KS1 performances.
