Yesterday we were extremely privileged to welcome the BBC presenter and scientist, Dallas Campbell to our school. This visit was thanks to the work of our ECO committee who in July participated in an EDF sponsored event, The Big Bumblebee Discovery. Children had to survey the number of bees in our school grounds and enter our results via an online blog alongside results from 2000 other schools. At the end of November we were informed that Worfield School had won a visit from Dallas Campbell; the top prize for participating in the survey! Children in Years 5 and 6 enjoyed an exciting afternoon meeting Dallas and asking him science based questions. They also got the opportunity to take part in a photo-shoot for local and national press.

Dallas' visit has really got our Year 5 and 6 children thinking about science in a different way. One of the best ways of teaching and inspiring young people is through real life experience, and I really hope that our children continue to show such enthusiasm for science for many years to come.

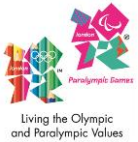
