Parents are most welcome to join us at the service. Please note that the centre pews and some side pews will be reserved for Worfield children to sit in their classes. Parents often get the best view of the children from the upstairs seating.

- TINNED MEALS e.g. curry; chilli; stewed steak and VEGETARIAN options
- Tins of FISH
- TINNED TOMATOES & TINNED VEGETABLES
- SOUP (tins or packet) & BAKED BEANS

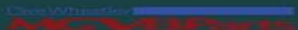
