We are continually trying hard to ensure that our children have access to healthy choices when in school through our fruit programme and healthy school lunches. To continue to support this aim, we request that children are provided with a piece of fruit to eat at break time - favourite snacks are strawberries, carrot sticks and bananas. Grapes must be cut in half to avoid a choking hazard. Please **DO NOT** send any nuts, or nut based products into school as some children have allergies.

The national school fruit scheme has now re-commenced so all nursery, reception and KS1 children will receive a piece of fruit to eat in school during the school day.

Children should also bring their own water bottle to school every day, all bottles must be named and taken home to be replenished at the end of the day.
