Dear Parent,

We are occasionally asked by parents whether they could run an after school club for our pupils. Often because of strict health and safety rules, the need for specific qualifications and fulfilling safeguarding requirements we have to decline these kind offers. However, we are tentatively exploring the possibility of paying for a small group of dedicated volunteers to participate in Multi-Skills training which, upon successful completion, would enable a volunteer to run a multi skills after school club. With sufficient interest across local schools within our Shropshire Sports Partnership we anticipate training could be run over a series of weekly twilight sessions at a local school during the Spring term. As school would need to pay for this accredited training we would require a commitment from volunteers to use their training to the benefit of the school. If you feel this opportunity could be for you then please speak to Mrs Berrow, School Sports Coordinator, to register your interest. An enhanced DBS check would also be required.

Mrs Berrow has also recently reviewed the impact of our use of the Sports Premium Grant. Through our very active involvement with the Shropshire School Sports Partnership, over 100 pupils have been able to represent our school at various sporting events and competitions during the last academic year and such is our commitment to our sporting provision that last year our school achieved the prestigious Gold School Games Mark.
