Dear Parent

We write to apologise on behalf of AIP for any distress which may have been caused due to inaccurate debt letters being sent out last week. We have shared our concerns with AIP who have acknowledged that there was a problem with their system. They are working to rectify this.

Please may we take this opportunity to clarify that all children in our Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 cohorts are eligible for the universal infant free school meal. Should any parent receive a letter requesting payment in respect of infant meals then please inform the school but ignore the letter. We would then take up the matter on your behalf with AIP.

Meals for children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 cost £2.10 a day. Lunch money should be sent in a clearly named envelope with the child's full name, class, amount enclosed and the actual days your child is taking a meal. Providing the days enables AIP to reconcile money paid with actual meals taken and should minimise system errors.

May we bring to your attention that all meals should be paid for in advance, daily, weekly or monthly. AIP's credit policy is for five days only and meals will not be provided by AIP on the sixth day unless payment is received. Parents would, in these circumstances, need to provide their child with a packed lunch but AIP would have made contact with you so that you were able to make these alternative arrangements.

Cash or cheques are accepted by AIP. If you have more than one child at Worfield School, you can pay for all meals on the same cheque. All cheques should be made payable to Alliance in Partnership and should be for a minimum value of £10.00.
