Important Safety Notice

The bell rings on the playground at **8.50am**. All children should then enter school, put their outdoor things away and settle down ready to start lessons. The school day starts at 8.55am.

Late children MUST be accompanied to the school office by an adult to be signed in. Children should not be left at the school gate to make their own way into school as the buildings are locked. It is also important for fire safety reasons that we record their presence on the premises.

Parents are reminded that the school offers a 'kiss and drop off' service from 8.35am. Parents can confidently drop their child off to the Teaching Assistant on duty in the bus area thus removing the need to bring your child into the playground. The duty TA will assume responsibility for your child and ensure they are taken with the bus children into school.

This service is only available to children who arrive before 8.50 and **not latecomers who must be signed in.**

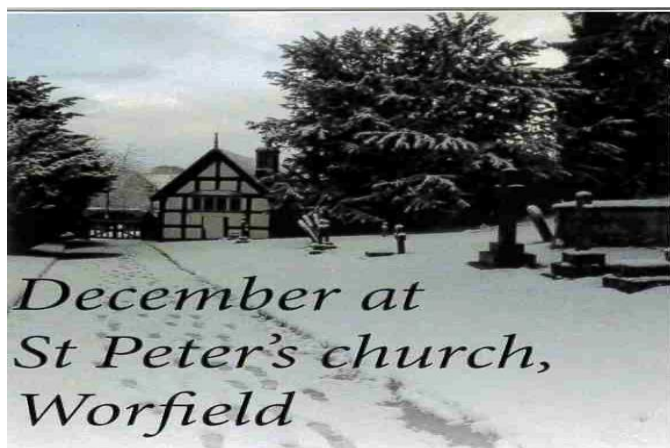
