Dear Parent,

We have been notified by the police and the local authority of recent suspicious incidents in the Oswestry and West Rhyn areas whereby children have been approached by strangers in cars.

Your child will have already been reminded about Stranger Danger today in response to these reports but I felt it important that parents should also be aware, particularly as we have a week off school and I know a number of children are likely to go out 'Trick or Treating'.

As parents and teachers we can protect our children from dangerous strangers by teaching them about strangers and suspicious behaviour. You may find the following website useful to help structure a conversation with your child.

Cross Country

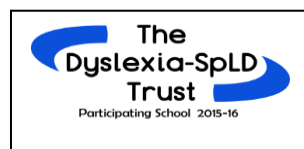
