Dear Parent,

Important information about emergency closures in the event of severe winter weather:

As the weather turns more wintery I would like to remind you of the procedures in the event of a school emergency closure. We will always endeavour to keep our school open unless there really is no sensible option but to close. Our school policy for emergency closures, which can be found on our school website, explains the times when closure may be necessary.

In the event of a closure being necessary I will liaise with the Chair of Governors and inform the local authority of our decision. The local authority will post up-to-date information on their website at shropshire.gov.uk/school-closures.

All radio stations will be linked to this information so parents can listen to any of their regular local radio stations from 8am for announcements on school closures. If your child's school is not mentioned then you should assume it is open. In addition, in the event of closure I will send a Text Tank message to all parents.

In the rare event that our school should need to close during the school day please be reassured that we will ensure arrangements are in place for every child to be collected. No child will be left out in the cold!

As the three schools in The Trinity Federation are in different locations and have different factors to consider; in the event of any possible school closure due to severe weather each school's circumstances will be considered separately.

I fully appreciate the impact a school closure can have and as such I hope that we do not need to close any of our schools but should there be the need, I hope that you now feel well informed about the procedures.
