Administering Medicine in School

In line with school policy, a 'Parental Request for Administration of Medicine' form can be found in our School Policies section on our website. If you wish your child to receive medication in school, the form (confirming the dosage and timing of the medicine) must be completed or an email should be sent to our admin address (admin@worfield.shropshire.sch.uk). You should also have a telephone conversation with Mrs Norgrove.

Children will not be given medication without written consent. Parents/ carers must hand the medication to a member of staff.

Medication cannot be sent to school with children on the school bus.
