Dear Parent,

I hope that the New Year has got off to a good start for you and your family. The children seem to have returned to school refreshed and ready for the term ahead.

Thank you to the small number of parents who returned their views on expanding our walking bus service. Unfortunately an end of the day walking bus service is not a viable option at this stage but this is an ongoing piece of work and things may change in the future. At a time when school budgets are under immense pressure it is only right that the funding we do have is targeted at teaching and learning and the cost of staffing the walking bus after school would take vital funds away from the classroom and unfortunately, very few families indicated that they would regularly use the service or use the service at all. I am most grateful to those of you who took the time to provide your comments; every comment has been reflected upon.

I am continuing to work with our Safer Schools Committee, the Parish Council and Shropshire Council with regards to parking issues in Worfield. We have received some fantastic poster competition entries from our children and we shall be judging these and awarding prizes next week. Winning posters will go up around the school site to remind everyone of the importance of parking with consideration for others, specifically with due regard for our neighbours in Mill Close who need access to their properties for hospital transport and emergency vehicles. The residents are most supportive of our school and frequently make a financial contribution to projects, including funding prizes for our poster competition.

During the disruption of the snow and on the day we had a lorry blocking access to Main Street, our kiss and drop off service served us well and reduced congestion in the heart of the village. Please do consider using this provision if you do not already do so.

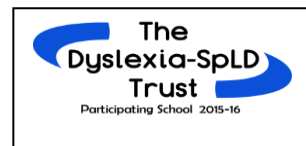
