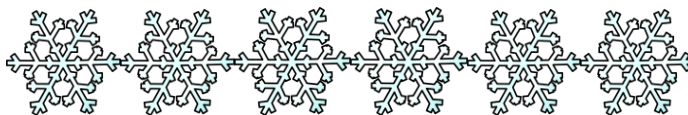

Please complete a form for each of your children to enable us to check the accuracy of the emergency contact information that we currently hold, and to update our records with any new or additional information. Also included on the form are questions relating to new data that we are now required to collect for the government's termly school census. Your prompt completion and return of the forms before Thursday 15th January would be much appreciated.



As wintery weather is now upon us, can I remind you of the procedures in the event of an emergency school closure. In the event of the school being closed the local authority will post the information on their website at shropshire.gov.uk/school-closures. All radio stations are linked to this information so parents can listen to any of their regular local radio stations from 8am for announcements on school closures. If Worfield School is not mentioned then you should assume it is open.

In addition, in the event of closure a text message will be sent to all parents. Please ensure when you complete the data collection form that you include the mobile phone number on which you would like to receive these messages from school.

I fully appreciate the impact a school closure can have and as such I hope that we do not need to close our school at any time but should there be the need in the coming months due to weather conditions, I hope that you now feel well informed about the procedures.
