Here is a reminder of our Winter uniform:

Boys' Uniform

White shirt (white polo shirts are only for Summer); school tie; grey trousers; grey socks; bottle green v-necked sweatshirt with school badge; black or brown plain shoes (not trainers).

Girls' Uniform

White blouse; school tie; sensible loose fitting knee-length grey skirt; pinafore dress or grey tailored trousers (not stretch); grey or white socks; bottle green v-necked sweatshirt or cardigan with school badge; black or brown plain shoes with sensible low heels (please note that high heels present a health and safety risk).

In the interests of safety the wearing of jewellery is not permitted. In the case of children with pierced ears, only studs may be worn. For health and safety reasons all jewellery must be removed for PE.

Your support and co-operation in ensuring your child is in full uniform will be very much appreciated. Please ensure all items of clothing are clearly named.
