Dear Parent,

This term we have reviewed the timing of the annual school reports to parents. In the light of the government's changes to the national grading system from levels to end of academic year "Age Related Expectations" and listening to feedback from parents, we will move away from the current spring term report to an end of the academic year report in the summer term.

We believe that this will allow teachers to be more precise in the monitoring and reporting of the standards achieved against the Age Related Expectations for each child for their year group. The report itself remains in the same format. Parents will receive their child's annual report on Friday 7th July, with an opportunity to discuss the report at a parent consultation evening soon after on Thursday 13th July.

In the interim, parents will be able to discuss the progress their child is making towards meeting the Age Related Expectations at a parents evening on Thursday 30th March.

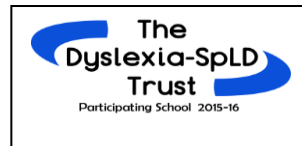
