Outstanding Gymnastics Coaching for Primary School aged children



Edge Gymnastics continue to run weekly sessions at Worfield School on Thursdays during term time. Edge Gymnastics is unique as while we are not a competitive fixed venue gymnastics club, we currently have an incredible amount of members...over 300 in fact! Enjoyment of the sport is at the core of everything we do and we are dedicated to ensuring sessions are fun and engaging and accessible to all children, regardless of their gymnastic ability or individual needs. Gymnastics is an amazing sport to become involved with not only can your child learn some visually impressive skills but they will grow in strength, flexibility and co-ordination and confidence. Our coaching staff are led by British Gymnastics qualified adults, fully insured and DBS checked and are supported by older gymnasts/sports leaders who are also BG qualified or working towards qualification.

Sessions at Worfield school run Thursdays 3.15-4.15pm (children come straight to the hall after school) and also 4.20-5.20pm. The early class is for Worfield pupils only but the later class can accept children from other schools (though Worfield and Beckbury children will always be given preference). Did you know that you can put your child's name down on the waiting list up to 2 years ahead of them starting primary school? We are currently accepting names on lists for up to and including 2021 school entry. All children from year R up to Year 6 can attend sessions and the group is then split into age/ability groups. Edge Gymnastics focuses on floor (sometimes using the airtrack) and vault work and we also incorporate routine work, acrobatic balances and undertake yearly British Gymnastics proficiency Awards. Sessions are currently £3.50 per week paid in half termly or termly blocks.
