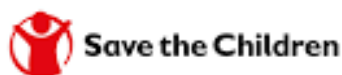
### WORLD STORY TELLING DAY

This year Worfield School would like to raise the profile of storytelling. To achieve this we will be celebrating World Story Telling Day on Monday 20<sup>th</sup> March. The theme for 2017 is 'Transformation.' Worfield will be retelling the story of 'The Papaya that Spoke.'

Storytelling serves to enhance the traditions and values of culture; the children will become gifted story tellers as they retell the story that they have rehearsed over a period of time using a series of actions.

World Story Telling Day is a global celebration of the art of oral storytelling. It is celebrated every year on the Spring equinox in the Northern Hemisphere, which is the Autumn equinox in the Southern Hemisphere. On World Storytelling Day, as many people as possible tell and listen to stories in as many languages and at as many places as possible, during the same day and night.

This event does **NOT** require any costumes.

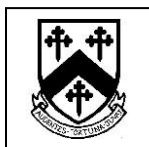
