Dear Parent/Carer,

Please be advised that from Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2016 there will be a price increase to the cost of a school meal. The current price is £2.00 for a main meal and a dessert. This will increase to £2.10 per meal.

The school has not implemented a price rise for the last 2 years but due to the continued pressure on the cost of wholesale food we cannot avoid this price increase any longer. It should be noted that a school meal still provides excellent value for money. Our prices remain amongst the lowest when compared with other schools nationally and we continue to work closely with Alliance in Partnership Catering Services who provide the catering service at our school to ensure they offer a varied range of meals which are both healthy and nutritious. All of their menus are developed in line with the nutritional standards set by the Schools Food Trust and the Government's Food Policy in Schools. These can be found on our website.

For our pupils in receipt of Free School Meals, the increase will be applied to the contribution made by the school.

I ask for your understanding with this price increase.
