The award ceremony which was held during the evening at Shrewsbury College was attended by Mrs Gaskin. The ceremony recognised the achievements of children and young people in Shropshire and Telford & Wrekin who have made a significant difference to the local community.

Leila and Kira were 'Highly Commended' by the High Sheriff for the fundraising work they did to raise money for children suffering in Aleppo.

There will be a special assembly in school on 5th April when the money Kira and Leila have raised will be presented to 'Save the Children'.

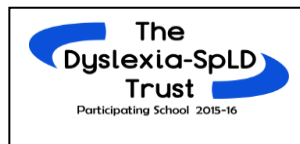
School uniform
