Although temperatures plummeted, the Worfield School step count went through roof as the children danced, skipped and ran their way to 13,080,404 steps! Exceeding the 5,000,000 step target we were aiming for.



There were many opportunities across the week to keep active. Tuesday saw the children clock up thousands of steps during Sally Smith's ZUMBA afternoon. Sally's fast-paced, high intensity sessions put teachers and pupils to the test - lots of fun was had by all. Even when it was too cold to get outside and do the daily mile, the children jumped into the hall where the Sport Relief hit, 'Step It Up', got them all moving and stealing steps where they could.
