Dear Parent,

We place great importance on good attendance and punctuality as we know that a child's attendance has a direct impact on their learning. Those children who are regularly absent from school and regularly late do not achieve their potential and do fall behind in class. Many children however attend school regularly and rarely miss a day. We want to encourage and celebrate excellent attendance. Our attendance policy, which can be found on our website, outlines all the ways in which we celebrate good attendance and also how we monitor attendance.

Throughout the summer term we will be running a class 'attendance challenge'. The school has a target of 97% attendance and we want to challenge all classes to meet or even exceed this target each week. Each week in our Monday celebration assembly we will be sharing the attendance percentage for each class for the previous week and we will also award all children who have 100% attendance with a wristband. Weekly, classes will be awarded points based on their overall attendance which will accumulate throughout the term. The greater the class attendance percentage the greater the number of points awarded. The class with the greatest number of points in the penultimate week of term will win a special class treat!

During the last week of the summer term, the class with the most attendance points will win a 'summer holiday' themed afternoon with ice-cream, a bouncy castle and much more! Classes will be able to check their class progress weekly on the display in the main entrance.

School closes today for the Easter break. Children return to school on Monday 24th April.

Cuan Wildlife Rescue

Cuan Wildlife Rescue will be visiting Y3 on Thursday 27th April. Cuan Wildlife Rescue is a registered charity dedicated to the care and rehabilitation of sick, injured and orphaned wild animals and birds. They will be teaching Wrekin Class about the care and rehabilitation of wildlife

Each year, Cuan admit around 2,000 wildlife casualties to their animal hospital where they receive immediate first aid and where necessary veterinary treatment to ensure injured wild creatures have the best possible chance of recovery.

Once they're well enough, the creatures are always returned to the wild.

Wrekin class will be collecting the following items which are **urgently needed by Cuan Rescue to provide care and treatment for injured creatures:**

- Cat food (not fish flavour)
- Dried mealworms
- Fleecy blankets
- Cotton wool balls and buds
- Sunflower hearts/wild bird seed
- Boxes of tissues
- Kitchen roll
- Non-latex surgical gloves
- Animal dishes
- Washing up liquid
- Dishcloths.
