### Review of the Disabled Children's Register in Shropshire

The Children Act 1989 requires all local authorities to keep a voluntary register of disabled children and young people (up to the age of 25) in the area. The aim of the register is to help local areas understand how many disabled children and young people (and those with special educational needs or some additional needs) live in their area and to assist them in planning provision and support.

Shropshire Council have asked an Independent person, Sue North, to review the current register and make some recommendations for the future.

Sue is working with PACC, Shropshire's parent carer forum, to find out how the current register works, and how it is used to

support families. Also how this helps the local area to use the information to plan good support and services for children and young people and their families in the future.
