Dear Parent,

As you may already be aware Mrs Grimsdale will be leaving her post as class teacher at Worfield School at the end of the summer term. Mrs Grimsdale has not made this decision easily but she needs to be able to spend more time with her parents as they make a move from Norwich to the Midlands. However, this week I have persuaded Mrs Grimsdale to remain involved with the school; teaching for a few hours each week from September and supporting professional development across the school.

Mrs Grimsdale has been a class teacher at Worfield since September 2010 and prior to completing her teacher training in 2009/10 had been a teaching assistant at the school for 8 years. Throughout her employment at Worfield School Mrs Grimsdale has shown an immense commitment to the school and the children; giving freely of her time outside school hours to enhance our Sports and PE provision, delivering SATs booster sessions and organising and supervising children on residential visits. Her hard work in the classroom has ensured that children make great progress in her class and I'm sure this year's SATs results will continue this trend. After a rigorous selection process which involved lesson observations in the teachers' current schools and a lengthy interview yesterday, two teachers have been appointed to join our staff team in September.
