Planned Industrial Action by Non-Teaching and Teaching Unions on Thursday 10 July 2014:

You may now be aware that there is a proposal that non-teaching members of the three main local government trade unions; Unison, GMB and Unite together with the National Union of Teachers (NUT) take strike action on Thursday 10 July 2014. I wish to inform you that despite a high number of teachers at Worfield School being members of one of the unions involved, these teachers have decided not to take strike action on this occasion but will instead continue to lobby parliament. Therefore, Worfield School will be open as usual to all pupils on 10th July. School buses are also not affected.

Parent consultation appointments are available with class teachers on Wednesday 16th July from 3.15 until 6pm. Pupil work will be available on this evening for parents to view. Please ensure that, if you wish to speak to your child's current class teacher, you return the parent consultation forms which accompany this letter. Week 5 – commencing 18th August. You are a star! Produce your own show.

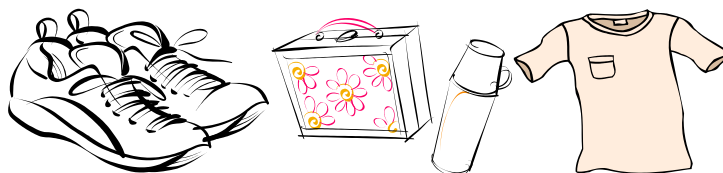
