SAFETY REQUEST



Following a minor incident in the playground after school earlier this week, please can I ask that parents support the school in reminding children that before and after school is not 'running around' playtime and that calm, social time is encouraged. Specifically, footballs from home are not to be brought into school. Whilst we do encourage exercise and physical activity during our mid-morning and lunchtime breaks, playing football on the playground before or after school is dangerous for younger siblings, particularly babies, and other people who are present on the playground at these times. Sports equipment and balls are made available at break times for children to use. These can be used safely at break times in the designated areas where others will not be harmed by flying balls or speeding children!



For safety reasons may I respectfully remind parents that they should not be allowing their children to play on the school field or trim trail after the end of the school day. In addition, school equipment should not be accessed by children or parents unless under the instruction or supervision of a member of school staff. We have become aware of damage to essential curriculum resources due to parents permitting children to use equipment out of school hours which has been laid out ready for afterschool sports clubs.
