Dear Parent,

I have pleasure in providing you with your child's annual school report which accompanies this newsletter. There is an opportunity to discuss the report with your child's class teacher next week should you wish to. Details of the date(s) offered by each teacher are included with the report.

You will notice that the report no longer gives a National Curriculum level for your child. This is because nationally, schools are in a period of transition with regards to assessment. As part of the coalition Government's reforms to the National Curriculum, the criterion-referenced assessment system of levels used to report children's attainment and to indicate progress was removed from September 2014. The new National Curriculum no longer refers to levels; just year group expectations. Schools are now able to introduce their own approaches to formative assessment, to support pupil attainment and progression. Should you have any questions regarding assessment these can be discussed with your child's class teacher.

Federation update:

As you may know, Ms Farrell Headteacher at St. Mary's Bluecoat School has now retired from her post as head teacher at St. Mary's School. I can confirm that I have now been appointed as Executive Headteacher across the federation continuing the role I started in September of this year. This is a different role to a traditional headteacher role and, as such, governors will be putting a new senior leadership team structure in place for September. This will be communicated to you in advance of the new school year.

This Tuesday 24th March is our special Easter service. This will be held at 9.30am at St Peter's Church and I look forward to seeing many of you there. This is an important event in the school calendar and the children will be taking part in the service.

May I take this opportunity to politely remind you that parking in and around the village is often difficult for this well attended event. Please be respectful of residents and other users of the village when parking your vehicles.

May I take this opportunity to thank you for your on-going support and wish you a happy Easter.
