Dear Parent,

Next week is 'Safer Internet Week' in school and children will be revisiting important ways to stay safe online. This is to coincide with Safer Internet Day on Tuesday 10th February. This Safer Internet Day the theme is 'Let's create a better Internet together' and young people from across the UK will be considering what they can do to help make the Internet a kinder place. Accompanying this newsletter is a parent factsheet which you may find helpful. We have also recently updated our federation 'Social Media, use of Mobile Telephones and Digital Photography' policy. Please help us to address our car parking concerns.

As you are aware, car parking space in Worfield is limited. The car park is designated for school staff use during school hours and for the use of parents who are delivering their child to Caterpillars, the private pre-school on our site. The rear school playground is available for parking before school and at the end of the school day.

With enough parental support, the Walking Bus from the Village Hall will soon be back in operation. Details were sent out earlier this week in a separate letter. Making use of the Walking Bus would give your child a healthy start to the day and reduce the number of cars coming into the village.

Do you need to park?

Parents are reminded that the school offers a 'kiss and drop off' service from 8.35am. Parents can confidently drop their child off to the Teaching Assistant on duty in the bus area thus removing the need to park. The duty TA will assume responsibility for your child and ensure they are taken with the bus children into school. Please note however, that this service is not available for latecomers who must always be signed in by their accompanying adult at the school office.



As an ECO school we also encourage car sharing as this limits the number of cars entering the village at key times. If you are interested in car sharing the school office may be able to support by linking you with parents who live near you to make your arrangements.
