This week Mrs Gaskin had a meeting with AIP our school meal provider. School meals are free for children in Reception class and Years 1 and 2. Children in KS2 should pay for their school meals which are priced at £2 per day.

School meals must be paid for in advance or on the day that they are taken. Children can only be provided with a school meal without prior payment in exceptional circumstances – such as when they have forgotten their packed lunch.

The maximum debt any parent is permitted before meals have to be stopped by AIP is -£10, after this point an emergency meal cannot be provided and parents will be asked to bring a suitable meal into school for their child.

Please remember to pay for your meals in advance and send money into school in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name and class.
